

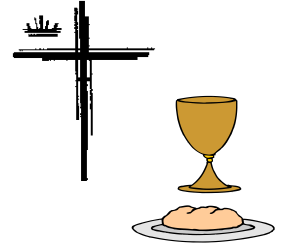

## THE COMMUNION PRAYER

The Lord is here.
