Sandra Lucas: mourning the loss of her niece Pauline who passed away the 23rd May 2019

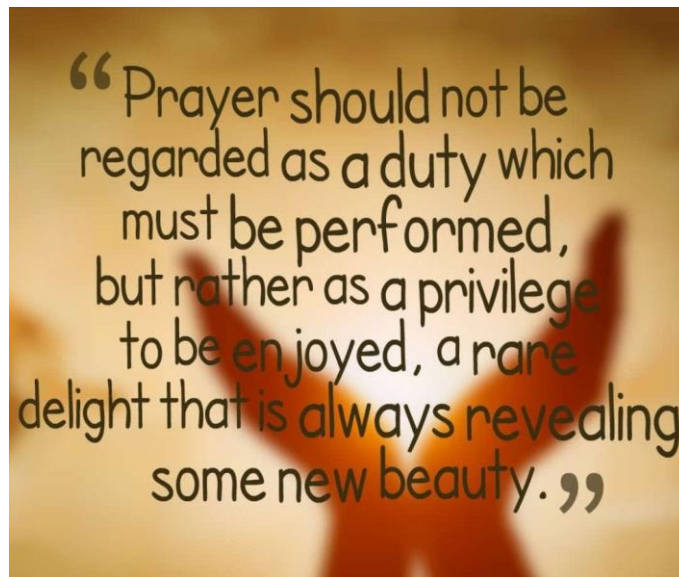
Beryl Hazelgrove expresses her thanks to all of you for your prayers for her daughter **Karen** and is very thankful to God for her recovery.
