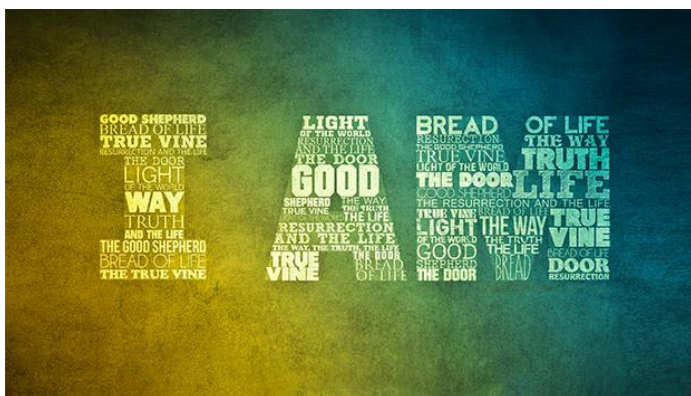
Morning Worship Online

Morning Worship will be broadcast at 10.30am on Sunday 21st June.

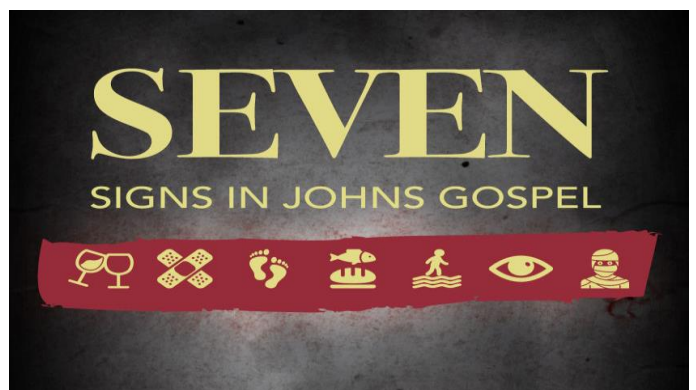
