Hungry Cow Puppet Craft


1. Cut out the pieces. Fold both the head base and the pink mouth in half down the middle.



3. Turn the craft over. Fold the ends back leaving around 3cm of the mouth showing.



5. Turn the craft over and fold the pink flaps down. Take the 2 top and bottom head pieces. Stick the straight edge of each one onto one of the white base ends.



2. Glue the pink mouth into the centre of the white head base, but keep both ends loose.



4. Do the same at both ends. Fold both pink flaps over but don't stick them down.




6. Repeat at the other end and then fold the pink flaps over and glue them down. Your mouth is now ready.



7. Glue the white teeth inside the folds at the top and bottom of the mouth. Glue the tongue just above the centre fold. Colour the gap between the 2 tongue parts black.



9. Now turn the craft over. Take the 2 handle strips and fold the ends inwards to make handles to fit the size of your hands.




Place your fingers in the top flap and your thumb in the bottom.



8. Glue the eyes, ears and horns onto the cow's face, and draw nostrils onto the nose with a black pen.



10. Glue the ends down to make two handles to hold your puppet.



You're finished! Enjoy your puppet!
