The Lion and the Lamb.

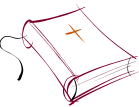

THE COMMUNION PRAYER

that this bread and this wine may be to
us the body and blood of your dear Son.

**As we eat and drink these holy gifts
make us one in Christ, our risen Lord.**
