ROADMAP TO FREEDOM

The PCC has discussed plans for the gradual and cautious return to normality at St James, keeping closely in step with the government's roadmap. Our hope is to be able to fully resume all services and other activities by September, assuming that the government's target of offering all adults at least one jab by the end of July has been met and that social distancing will have been lifted. The first phase of the plan has already begun, as we are now showing the pre-recorded service on the big screen in church each Sunday at 10.30am. Our hope is to be able to introduce some further stepping stones on the path towards normality, in an incremental and phased way, over the months leading up to September, until we are fully back to normal church life.
