



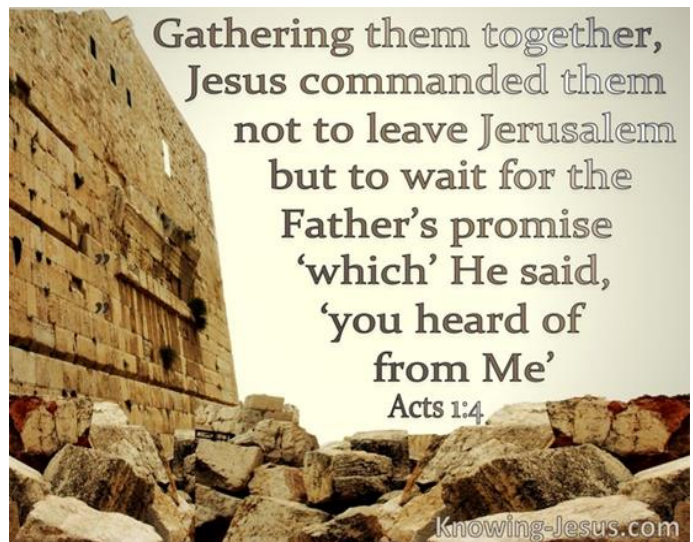

Paula Thomas has recently finished training as a Debt Coach for CAP, which involves visiting clients who are in debt in their homes, gathering information about their situation and delivering advice on routes to help them become debt free. It is also an opportunity to speak to people about Jesus. For safeguarding reasons Paula needs to be accompanied on her visits by someone from one of the local churches, known as a 'befriender', who would also become a contact for the client if they needed someone to talk to. It doesn't require training and Paula will only be seeing one new client per month so the commitment isn't huge.
